Further InterUrbino in Italy

Solaris will deliver fifteen 12-metre InterUrbino buses to Italy. The buyer is an operator from Biella, a town north-west of Milan. This is another order from Italy for this very model of Solaris buses.

Biella Province Bus Company, Azienda Trasporti Automobilistici Pubblici delle Province di Biella e Vercelli (ATAP), has purchased fifteen InterUrbino 12, which will be the first Solaris buses in the operator's fleet. The customer will receive all of them until the end of the year.

The vehicles ordered are fitted with DAF MX-11 powered engines developing 271 kW, which meet the most restrictive Euro 6 emission standards. Up to 54 passengers are able to travel in the spacious InterUrbino and enjoy comfortable seats with reclining backrests and adjustable armrests. Airconditioning in the whole passenger compartment ensures the pleasure of the journey even on hottest days. Moreover to increase the drivers' comfort, their cabin is equipped with a separate cooling system. There is luggage space provided in compartments located under the floor, which have a capacity of 5.2 m³. Smaller bags fit perfectly in the luggage racks installed above the seats. For the benefit of passengers with mobility impairments, there an electric lift is installed in the vehicle next to the central doors.

The contract with Biella is not an unusual order for intercity buses in Italy. Solaris has recently finalised an agreement with Ferrovie Appulo-Lucane. The regional operator from the coastal city of Bari has been driving Solaris InterUrbino already. Now it has purchased a further five 12-metre buses.

So far Solaris has delivered almost 350 buses and trolleybuses to Italian operators. Among these, 40 InterUrbino make up a significant share. At the present moment, buses with a Solaris's green dachshund mascot at a front are running in Ancona, Bari, Bologna, Cagliari, Genoa, Naples, Parma and Rome among other Italian places.
